October 2010 PRIMARY, PARTS I & II (FINAL) FELLOWSHIP EXAMINATIONS

The **October 2010** Fellowship Examinations of the West African College of Surgeons (WACS) in the Faculties of Anaesthesia, Dental Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Ophthalmology, Otorhinolaryngology, Radiology and Surgery, will be held at the University College Hospital (UCH), Ibadan, Nigeria and Korle-Bu Teaching Hospital (KBTH), Accra, Ghana from 15th to 26th October 2010

2. National Centre for Women Development, Abuja, Nigeria
3. Korle-Bu Teaching Hospital (KBTH), Accra, Ghana
4. National Orthopaedic Hospital, Enugu, Nigeria
5. Connaught Hospital, Freetown, Sierra Leone

THE PRIMARY EXAMINATIONS WILL HOLD ON FRIDAY 15TH OCTOBER 2010 FOR ALL FACULTIES.

THE PARTS I & II EXAMINATIONS WILL HOLD FROM 18TH OCTOBER 2010, IN UCH IBADAN, NIGERIA AND KBTH ACCRA, GHANA.

REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates applying to sit the **Primary Fellowship** examinations must be Medical Practitioners who are fully registered in Nigeria, Ghana, Liberia, Sierra Leone or The Gambia, and who have acquired at least one year post-registration experience.
- Candidates applying to sit the **Part I Fellowship Examinations** must have passed the **Primary Examination** of the West African College of Surgeons or its equivalent and satisfactorily completed appropriate years of residency training as prescribed by the relevant Faculty.
- Candidates applying to sit the **Part II (Final) Fellowship Examinations** must have passed the **Part I Fellowship Examinations** of WACS and satisfactorily completed appropriate years of Residency training as prescribed by the relevant Faculty. Candidates are required to submit their Dissertations/casebooks with their application forms. Further details are available in the Prospectus of the College. The new College **Prospectus** is available for sale at the College Secretariat.
